Technical description

Eco-friendly lamp made from paper pulp obtained using old newspapers.

The story behind the lamp: Belongs to the collection of two lamps which name refers to the name of the dwarf planet called Pluto. Its structure is changing while orbiting around the Sun and that fact become a source of inspiration for me to create two lamps. Pluto's internal structure consists of dense core of rocks surrounded by a mantle of ice. Its orbit is elongated and when Pluto is closer to the Sun - the temperature increase causing the ices to sublimate into gas. This version is delicate and the layer of paper is not so intense.
